Ann-Marie DiFranco, Enrichment Teacher, Citizens Academy, a Breakthrough School

Presentation Topic/Description: *Collaborating Through Technology*

Ann-Marie will share how students are able to collaborate with other students and members of the community by using programs such as *LEGO WeDo2.0*, *Girls Who Code*, and the *Kids Film It Festival*. She will share evidence that demonstrates students working together, brainstorming, facing challenge, being rewarded for their work by winning awards! Citizens Academy is a K-5 school located in the Glenville neighborhood of Cleveland.

Presentation Topic/Description: *Accessibility for All*

Erica will demonstrate how she utilizes technology to provide an accessible classroom for all types of learners in a "co-serve" classroom. In her presentation, she will share a variety of apps and accessibility features. Some examples of integrated tech tools include *Screencastify*, iPad accessibility features, talk-to-text with *Google Drive*, the *Show Me* app, a green screen, and a *GoPro*.

Presentation Topic/Description: *Using Technology in Music Class is Out of This World: Musical Adventures in Outer Space*

Jim will share the ways he uses instructional technology as a music teacher. His presentation will focus on an outer space themed lesson that incorporates technology in a fun and meaningful way for students.
