



Weekly Classroom Support Materials

Beneath weekly episodes, teachers can find the following resources to support the use of full *NewsDepth* episodes as an instructional tool:

Download Video

Video files are made available on the website early Thursday mornings. For teachers in districts that discourage streaming videos or have a poor internet connection, files can be easily downloaded for use at a later time.

Download Transcript

Transcripts provide a text-based resource that students can use to follow along while viewing episodes. Teachers can skim transcripts for content and can support the use of informational text in the classroom setting.

Download Guide

Episode guides provide a rundown of stories that appear in the episode along with the relevant learning standards. Word highlights, poll questions, and write-in questions are also included along with additional discussion questions related to the episode.

These guides are developed to aid teachers in lesson planning, delivery, and standards and curricular alignment. They can be accessed early by signing up for the weekly *NewsDepth* e-newsletter on the “Connect with Us” page.

Episode worksheets can be used by students while viewing to engage listening skills and to assess whether students comprehend the content of each news story.



Add Digital Worksheet to Google Classroom

The worksheets are available as a PDF download or as a Google Form that can be added to a teacher’s Google Classroom. Both are located on full episode pages, directly beneath the video.



Add Full Episode to Google Classroom

Adding Full Episodes of *NewsDepth* to Google Classroom allows teachers to easily assign viewing of the show in their virtual classrooms. *NewsDepth* assignments come prefilled with a summary of the show.
